## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Greetings Members!

Happy Holidays! It has been a true honor to serve this last year as President and Education Chair. The pleasure of meeting many of you across the state, whether in education or at a social

event have been highlights.

#### **MEMBERSHIP UPDATE**

As of the date of this writing and since my last message, we have added several new members, including (1) Student Affiliate and (2) Practicing Affiliates and (1) Designated member. The net change results in a total of 196 Active Members. Welcome New Members!

Even though I roll off as President in 2024, I will be around as Immediate Past President and Education Chair. I will continue to make data-driven decisions, and allow your input guide our what and where education is offered.

Congratulations to the newly elected 2024 Board of Directors, and special shoutout to Tyson Hall, MAI, elected to a second consecutive term on the Board of Directors! We are in great hands. Our Board of Directors is in the process of approving the 2024 budget, which should be finalized by mid-January. After evaluating a variety of metrics over the last year, we are determined now more than ever to continue with an aggressive approach to providing in-person education across the State of Wisconsin. This includes a mix of nationally developed AI courses, and homegrown education for both commercial and residential appraisers alike.

I am optimistic about recent changes at the Department of Safety and Professional Services. They are implementing a new system to improve efficiency in the review process for applications seeking approval for Continuing Education. This should further improve the lead times between the time an event is organized, approved for CE, and when we can formally bring it to market, promote it and take registrations.

I currently have about one dozen courses on a variety of topics, pending schedule and approval prior to opening up registrations for 2024. I expect to have our slate of offerings finalized by the end of Q1 2024. This slate of offerings will include Designation Education for our Candidates; something we have not been able to do for quite some time.

As new education gets developed and is discovered over the course of the year, I will continue to seek input from members on what and where this education should be offered. We will continue to reach members from Milwaukee, central-Wisconsin to the Fox Valley areas.

### GOVERNMENT RELATIONS COMMITTEE & PAREA

Thank you to Kimberly MacPherson, Candidate and Jorge Barreiro, SRA, AI-RRS for your efforts over the last year managing legislative initiatives. AI-PAREA has officially launched and has been implemented in other states in the region. In my most recent conversations with the State of Wisconsin Appraiser Board, Wisconsin is still in the early stages of adoption of the Practical Applications of Real Estate Appraisal (PAREA) into state law. It is estimated to be approved and adopted, in some form or another, as early as Q4 2024- but likely in early 2025. Our Government Relations Committee members will continue to be diligent and engaged as discussions take place with respect to how state law will be written and how PAREA will ultimately be adopted.

#### THE MARKET & OPPORTUNITIES

We have come full circle since our last newsletter – and I am optimistic. It was unclear how prevailing market conditions were going to impact appraisers during the course of 2023. There has been some relief in the market generally since interest rates have declined from their peak near 8% over the last couple of months - where they are down to mid- 6% (as of this writing). Experts are suggesting that this dip in rates will persist, bring relief, and have a positive impact on the market overall.

There are many changes coming in the next 12 months, particularly for residential appraisers that primarily work in mortgage lending. On the one hand, this may prove to be challenging; but, there are also many opportunities. Despite increased use of Value Acceptance, use of hybrid appraisal and evaluation products, and the implementation of the new FNMA forms and delivery system (expected late 2024 to early 2025), I am optimistic. Fundamentals will shift. Inventory will increase. Prices may stabilize, continue to increase, or even decrease in certain market segments. Appraisers will be needed more than ever to wade through volatility, and make sense of these changes for users of appraisal services.

Change is happening and I look forward to connecting with you all in 2024 to discuss it. Be sure to watch out for our Residential Appraisal Practice Group invitations, where we have guest speakers deliver the latest insights into current market conditions. I expect to see agenda items added for discussion such as PAREA implementation, new FNMA forms, GSE policy changes, etc.

Thank you again for the opportunity to serve our Chapter. Have a wonderful New Year!!



# <u>2024-2025 National USPAP Update Course -</u> 7 Hours of CE

#### WCAI Chapter Office - Milwaukee

This required 7-hour continuing education course, copyrighted by The Appraisal Foundation, focuses on USPAP requirements for ethical behavior and competent performance by appraisers. The first part of the course addresses the changes to USPAP, which are effective January 1, 2024, and the second focuses on cases studies that challenge you how to apply USPAP to situations you encounter in your daily practice. The course will help you gain competency in USPAP, and it will help those subject to state licensing or certification and continuing education requirements imposed by professional organizations, client groups, or employers gain competency as well.

In the past, the Advisory Opinions and Frequently Asked Questions, which were required materials for the course, were bundled with the USPAP publication. Now they are contained in a separate publication, USPAP Guidance and Reference Manual. This manual provides examples showing the applicability of standards in specific situations and offers advice from the ASB for resolving appraisal issues and problems. It also contains the Reference Index which is a highly useful tool that helps appraisers quickly find answers to USPAP-related questions. This new Guidance and Reference Manual is included with your course handbook. Please note, however, that USPAP 2024, which includes Standards 1-10 and is required for the course, must be purchased separately.
